July 10, 1875—May 18, 1955

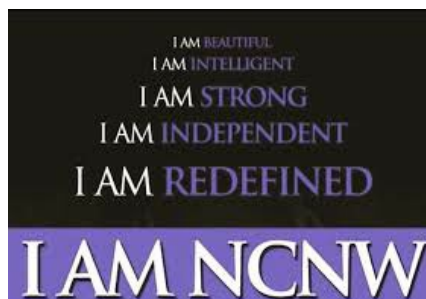
